Dust Suppression - Technology and Investment



At Allstone, it's our mission to deliver consistent safety and environmental improvements.

As a result, the business is delivering positive change to environmental dust control, via the daily use of a dedicated dust suppression bowser, and occupational dust control via the installation of a "Mist Air", dust suppression system.

As a market leader in innovative, practical, and reliable dust suppression techniques, Mist Air have provided a state-of-the-art system delivering significant benefits to

the recycling facility.

This ground-breaking system uses fan, pump and spray technology to produce artificial "fog" from a stored water supply. This process enables fugitive dust emissions to be eliminated at source, whilst avoiding wetting the area and creating additional slip hazards.

Both the environmental and occupation control improvements further outline our ongoing commitment to improving the environment for all.

Over the past 12 months, a huge investment in time, money and effort has seen the delivery of a network of new internal drainage pipes, channels and interceptors.

This work delivers real-world improvements in the reduction in nuisance surface water, which in turn reduces the risk of mud and other debris collecting on the site.

These efforts, coupled with the use of our owned and operated "Speedy Sweep" vehicle are proving to make a real difference to the working and local environment.
